Dear Licensing department

I would like to object to Chicago Booth's licensing application on the grounds of public nuisance, which will be spread across the week given the nature of Chicago Booth's application.

I am the owner of an apartment in Askew House, Barts Square, which is a residential area with over 230 flats.

The noise and disturbance caused by having people arriving and leaving a late-night venue, potentially seven days a week, would have a dramatic and deleterious impact on the environment around this development.

In Barts Square the City of London Corporation approved a development that has brought people to live in the area. To approve a late-night notice in this area would be paradoxical to the rationale behind developing Barts Square as a residential area.
