

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 1) In the event of the transmission of any recognised international event which falls outside the current permitted hours on the premises licence to permit the sale of alcohol and provision of hot food commencing one hour before the start of the event and ending one hour after the end of the event, the details of the activity to be notified to the police 10 days beforehand, with the Police giving their prior written consent in all cases.
- 2) On the days/dates listed below the additional hours are to be permitted for the licensable activity (not including drinking up time) – 1st January 1hr, 1st March (St David's) 1 hr, 17th March (St Patrick's) 2hrs, Easter Sunday 1hr, Easter Monday 1hr, May Bank Holiday (1st) Sunday prior 2hrs, May Bank Holiday (1st) Bank Holiday Monday 1hr, May Bank Holiday (2nd) Sunday prior 2hrs, May Bank Holiday (2nd) Bank Holiday Monday 1hr, August Bank Holiday Sunday prior 2 hrs, August Bank Holiday Monday 1hr, Halloween 2 hrs, Christmas Eve 2hrs, Boxing Day 2hrs, 27th December 2hrs, 28th December 2hrs, 30th December 2 hrs. In respect of Opening Hours on commencement of British Summer Time one hour should be added to the finish time.

Additional Conditions

- 3) CCTV System will be in operation at all times that the public are on the premises.
- 4) Permission is given for the playing of recorded music.
- 5) The sale of alcohol is permitted from opening time on New Year's Eve until closing time on New Year's Day.
