Whilst I welcome more venues that may be open at the weekend I feel that the opening hours are too late and off-sales may encourage street drinking diminishing the area, creating noise/anti-social behaviour and littering. If more like a traditional pub I would welcome this environment but still feel that a limit of 10 or 11pm is more acceptable. Note that the nearest pub the Samuel Pepys is open only Monday to Friday albeit is even closer to residential buildings.
