Zoological Society of London (25764)	£13,448 over two years towards equipment and staffing costs to support the implementation of Hedgehog and wildlife monitoring, and local community engagement in Hampstead Heath and Highgate woods.	Approved
Epping Forest Heritage Trust (25950)	£10,500 across one year to support the Epping Forest Heritage Trust's Happy Loppers and Green Team volunteers, contributing towards the costs of a Conservation Officer, alongside insurance.	Approved
Oxygen (25962)	£14,980 (£7,490; £7,490) over two years for staffing, activities, publicity and monitoring costs associated with the Ashted Outdoors Adventure Programme - introducing marginalised and disadvantaged young people to the benefits of nature on Ashted Common.	Approved
Tinder Sticks CIC (25967)	£8,957 over twelve months for staff time, training and equipment for 'Wander Women': creating a positive connection with West Ham Park for vulnerable local women, building outdoor confidence and improving well-being.	Approved
Highams Park Community CIC (26021)	£2,500 over six months to improve the appearance and biodiversity of the north end of Highams Park Lake through planting of appropriate bog friendly plants.	Approved
Lower Mole Countryside Trust (25889)	£14,995 over 3 years to manage habitat, purchase species monitoring equipment and recruit volunteers to help save the nationally threatened Hazel Dormouse on Ashted Common National Nature Reserve.	Approved
The Conservation Volunteers (25812)	£8,200 (£4,000; £4,200) across two years to Boosting Biodiversity – Croydon TCV supporting Rangers to maintain and improve City Commons.	Approved
Faiths Forum for London (25437)	£14,850 over 9 months to support the costs of staffing, venue hire, equipment, and promotional materials for a "Biodiversity Bug School."	Rejected
Heath Hands (25776)	£15,000 towards Young Hedgerow Heroes to enable children to boost biodiversity and improve climate resilience on Hampstead Heath through practical conservation work.	Rejected
The Good Gym (26001)	£13,661 over one year towards staffing and marketing costs associated with delivering 70 environmental activities in City of London green spaces.	Rejected
