Withdrawn Applications:

Organisation

Purpose of Request

Shoreditch Town Hall Trust

“Installation of a passenger and goods lift to access first and second floors.”

Organisation has withdrawn the application following negotiations with your officer.

Richmond Youth Partnership

“To help support salary costs to maintain a youth-friendly counselling service to improve the emotional wellbeing of young people aged 11-25 living in Richmond and surrounding areas.”

The project seeking funds has established itself as a new charity and the organisation therefore wishes to withdraw its current application in order to be considered in the future.

Upswing Aerial Limited

“Develop a programme of workshops for

and with older people using circus and aerial movement to promote positive ageing, health, wellbeing, self-esteem and creativity.”

The financial information for this newly registered charity is not sufficiently clear. Accordingly, the organisation accepted your officer's advice to withdraw the application.

Women's Health & Family Services

“To recruit and train older volunteers to our volunteering programme of health projects offering support and befriending to vulnerable and isolated local people.”

Application withdrawn by applicant to resubmit at a later date.

Action on Hearing Loss

“Hear to Meet befriending clubs enable people with hearing loss to informally meet over a cup of coffee and exchange experiences and information reducing isolation.”

Following discussions with your officer, the organisation has decided to withdraw the application and resubmit a proposal at a later date.

British Polio Fellowship

“Provide Disability Benefits Officer to advise members, Support Services Team on welfare benefits, monitoring changes in benefits legislation and updating benefits publications. eg. PIP.”

The organisation has accepted your officer's advice to withdraw this application, as it appears that it may have sufficient reserves to fund this work itself.

Time for Families

“Relationship courses in HMP Brixton. Strengthening prisoners relationships to improve re-integration and reduce the chance of prison recall.”

This application has been withdrawn following the organisation's merger with another charity after the application was submitted.
