### Summary

You receive two sample monitoring visit reports at each of your meetings. These are in addition to the two substantial monitoring reports you receive annually. One of these, a report reflecting on issues arising from the monitoring and evaluation of grants was presented to your February 2013 meeting whilst a statistical monitoring report looking at trends in your Working with Londoners grant-making programmes is included in the papers for today's meeting.

Reports to this Committee are from visits to Read - The Reading Agency and Women's Environmental Network Trust. Read – The Reading Agency was awarded funding under your Improving Londoners' Mental Health programme, whilst Women's Environmental Network Trust received a grant under your London's Environment programme.

You support Read – The Reading Agency's work to promote literacy in London's prisons. Mrs Littlechild and Mr Seaton participated in the visit which included the opportunity to meet participants as well as staff from HMP Wandsworth.

Your grant to Women's Environmental Network Trust is for an urban food growing programme for unemployed Black Asian and Minority Ethnic women in Hackney. This is a small charity which has delivered high quality work with your funding.
