The application is about making music venues more accessible to deaf and disabled audience whereas your revenue programme aims to increase the active participation of deaf and disabled people in the arts. It therefore falls outside your current priorities.	£130,294	JF Camden
12442 Community Health Action Trust	To empower, motivate and support disabled people go back to work/training in order to maintain choice and control in their lives and live economically independent.	The applicant has not set out a convincing case of need to establish a new employment service for disabled people and those with AIDS/HIV living in Brent. Also it has not demonstrated a track record in providing this type of service which raises concerns about the organisation's ability to meet your stated outcomes.	£181,566	JXM Brent
12433 Hoxton Hall	Capital works focusing on access (new DDA compliant entrance) for grade II* listed Music Hall Theatre, phase 2 of a £5m, 5 year masterplan.	Organisation received capital funding for access work in 2011, which was reported on in March 2013. 12311 Royal British Legion Industries	To deliver LifeWorks to ex servicemen and civilian current prisoners with a guaranteed 6 month workplacement on completion of course who are in Wandsworth Prison.	The funding requested has been reduced from £30K p/a for 2 years to £24,260 p/a for 2 years. It would be used solely to provide 10 days training benefitting 10 prisoners. This would be followed by a 6 month placement (not the subject of this application) with a track record to date of 48% then securing sustained employment. Officers are of the view that there is insufficient benefit to justify funding at this time.	£60,000	JF Wandsworth
