- 1. Billingsgate Corporate Account favourable variance to date and projected year end surplus is mainly due to additional car parking income.
- 2. Smithfield Service Charge favourable variance to date and projected year end underspend is due to salary savings on vacant posts; savings on the Citigen hot water budget, which will reduce over over the winter period as consumption increases; and savings on the water and electricity budgets.
- 3. Smithfield Corporate and Direct Recovered underspend to date is mainly due to timing of works completed from the carry forward budget of £213,000. This budget should have been used by March 2015, however, the City Surveyor has encountered procurement issues which have delayed the works.
